The orchestra activity fee is an annual contribution from all parents/guardians of Johns Creek High School Orchestra members. Orchestra fees cover numerous expenses incurred by the orchestra during the school year, including orchestra-related activities (such as festivals, special events and performances), cost of clinicians (for specialized workshops/performances), program expenses (such as sheet music, CDs, recordings, new instruments), maintenance expenses (such as instrument accessories/repairs, piano tuning), awards (festival medals, letters, pins, plaques, trophies presented to students at the orchestra end-of-the-year banquet), and miscellaneous expenses (such as reception refreshments, t-shirts, etc...).

Fulton County *does not* provide the funds necessary to cover the expenses listed above. Your orchestra fee has a direct impact on the quality of the Johns Creek High School Orchestra program and on the quality of music education students will receive.

This year, due to COVID-related situation, the activity fee will be reduced from \$175.00 to \$100.00.
